

November 11th is Veteran's Day and to help our students to understand the significance of the service past and present service men and women have made to our society, we will visit the National Infantry Museum in Columbus, GA on Wednesday, November 9th. Our students will be part of *Securing Our Freedom Program* which includes a film and private tour detailing the role our military heroes play in securing and maintaining our freedom as an American people.
